

Governors Maintenance and Contingency Fund

As Trent is a Voluntary Aided School it is funded slightly differently to Local Authority Schools. Funds for the maintenance and upkeep of the buildings and capital expenditure on ICT (Information and Communication Technology) is the responsibility of the Governors so these funds are not delegated as part of the usual School Budget.

Therefore, the parents are asked to make an annual voluntary contribution to support this aspect of the schools budget. These funds are entirely separate from the main school budget and are managed by the Governors.

Your Contribution

We suggest a minimum voluntary donation of £30 per child per term (September, January and April) but some families may be able to give more. Also, taxpayers can sign the Gift Aid Form and this allows the school to claim an additional 20% back from the government. All contributions are voluntary and totally confidential. These donations can be made through our School Money payment system.

The Maintenance and Contingency Fund enables the school to make continuous and tangible improvements to the School buildings, outside environment and education of the children.

In the last few years the donations received from our parents have enabled us to carry out some exciting projects and improvements including:-

2016 - £9,000 for redesign and upgrade to KS1 toilets 2019 £20,000 for redesign of reception playground
